



2026 Ashton Woods Pool Rules and Information

All pool members are responsible for reading these rules and discussing them with their household and guests. These rules are designed for the safety of all members and the protection of your privileges.

The rights, privileges and safety of all Ashton Woods Owner's Association and Douglas Aquatics management, staff and lifeguards, *herein known as "Pool Committee"*, should be respected at all times by members and guests alike.

Failure to follow these rules below will be grounds for removal from the pool and will result in revocation of pool passes for the household on file. No exceptions.

Ashton Woods Owner's Association and Douglas Aquatics management, staff and lifeguards, *herein known as "Pool Committee"*, have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations including:

- Suspending member privileges for any violation of the Pool Rules.
- Restricting the use of any audio devices if the volume is too loud.
- Closing the facility for safety, sanitation or weather related issues.
 - Dispose of any articles left at the facility
 - Notify law enforcement if necessary.

Please always show the Pool Committee the respect they deserve while keeping you, your family members and guests safe.

There is active 24 hour video surveillance around the common area including the pool and pool house.

Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and will result in revocation of Pool Passes for all members of the household on file.

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Members and Guests

All members and guests MUST show passes to Lifeguards and sign in at the Lifeguard Desk upon entry every time they enter the pool facility.
No exceptions.

Pool doors will open at 12pm and will remain locked until that time.

Members must remain with their guest(s) at all times regardless of age. Members are responsible for their guest(s) at all times.

Ashton Woods families can bring in ONE guest free of charge. Every guest thereafter is \$5 per visit payable by cash to the Lifeguards upon entry.

Ashton Woods residents can bring in a maximum of 3 guests per visit.

We offer a limited amount of Outside Memberships to families outside our community. We keep this number very small so as to not crowd our pool and facilities. These memberships have been vetted and referred by Ashton Woods homeowners in good standing. Outside Members are expected to abide by the same rules and policies as Ashton Woods residents.

Outside Members do not receive a free guest pass. Outside Members can bring in a maximum of 3 guests per visit. Each guest is \$5 per visit payable by cash to the Lifeguards upon entry.

Children under 16 years of age and under must be under the supervision of an adult member at ALL TIMES. They cannot enter the facility on their own. They cannot bring in their own guests. They must remain with an active adult member at all times. If an adult member leaves their child for any period of time unattended the Pool Committee will remove said child from the pool and the adult member will be notified to come pick up their child immediately.

Members cannot bring in guests of Ashton Woods homeowners that are not in good standing. This includes homeowners and their children who are not current with their yearly dues or homeowners and their children who have been previously removed from the pool and asked not to return. Any member who breaks this rule will have their passes revoked for the season. No exceptions.

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SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Lifeguards will be on duty at all times whenever the pool is occupied.

The Pool Committee reserves the right to close the pool when it is cloudy, foggy or the outside temperature is 69 degrees or below.

Members will be asked to leave the pool facility when weather requires that the pool be closed either temporarily or for the day.

All hair longer than shoulder length should be secured with a hair tie.

Glass is NOT permitted inside the pool gates, this includes baby bottles.

Bikes, roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, hoverboards or the like are NOT allowed inside the pool gates.

Eyeglasses needed while in the pool should be secured with a strap.

Small children and weaker swimmers are restricted to pool depths not exceeding their shoulder level (*as determined by a lifeguard*).

Running, dunking, pushing, shoulder riding, chicken-fighting or other rough play is NOT permitted.

One person at a time is allowed on the diving board. Members/guests must form a line behind the diving board stairs and wait their turn.

No flotation or safety devices are to be used off diving board. The diving board is for SWIMMERS only. Swimmers must dive or jump straight out from the board. NO jumping or diving towards either side of the pool and no diving or jumping into another person's arms. THE DIVING BOARD IS FOR THOSE WHO CAN SAFELY SWIM AND DIVE ON THEIR OWN. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Back flips are NOT permitted from the diving board or pool deck at any time.

No hanging from the diving board, lifeguard stands or lap ropes.

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Alcohol is not permitted on the property. Illegal substances are not permitted on the property. The Pool Committee has the right to turn away any member or guest believed to be intoxicated or under the influence of any substance.

Food and drinks cannot be consumed inside or near the pool. All food and drinks should be consumed around the table areas (this includes chairs).

The Kiddie Pool is for children age 5 or under (unless otherwise given special permission) and children **MUST BE SUPERVISED BY THEIR ADULT AT ALL TIMES. There is no lifeguard assigned to the kiddie pool area.**

Children 16 and under cannot be left unattended at for ANY TIME for ANY REASON.

Chemical Safety Checks will be called at 45 minutes past each hour to allow for safely checking chemical levels. Only adults 18 or older are allowed in the pool during this time. All others must leave the water.

COURTSEY PROTOCOLS

The use of profanity and inappropriate or lewd behavior is NOT permitted. This is a family friendly pool and as proudly operated as such.

Smoking or Vaping inside or around the pool gates or pool house is NOT permitted.

When leaving for the day, please throw away all trash and return your chairs back to their rightful place. Please return all used floats, life preservers and toys to their locations.

Water and squirt guns are NOT PERMITTED. No exceptions.

Throwing balls, frisbees or boomerangs is not permitted inside the pool.

Two-person floats are not permitted as they will crowd the pool and obscure smaller children from the Lifeguards' field of vision. One float per household is permitted.

Shoes should be worn when entering the pool house.

Bathing Suits **MUST** be worn at all times. Cut-offs, jeans, t-shirts, tank tops and undergarments are not permitted.

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Inappropriate behavior by adults and children alike will NOT BE TOLERATED and are grounds for dismissal. Refusing to exit the premises once asked will result in the Pool Committee calling law enforcement to assist with the situation.

As previously stated, the Pool Committee reserves the right to revoke passes for any member that is in violation of these rules. Suspension from the pool includes the ENTIRE common area, beginning from the main gate to the pool.
